RE: CONFIRMATION PROGRAM/ Class Service Planning

Your class service projects:

- **ONLY ONE CLASS SERVICE PROJECT REQUIRED**
- If possible your class project should be performed during 1st Semester (before or during Christmas break). A second project or continuation of your 1st semester project could be performed before or during Spring break if you choose to do a second class service project.
- Should be performed at a date and time of your choice (not during a regular class time).
- Can be performed here at St. Joseph's in your classroom or in another area in the building; let me know in enough time to reserve space for you.
- Can be performed at your home – you will have to get a copy of permission forms for your students from Toni Rapach.
- Can be performed offsite at a service location (such as a nursing home) - you will have to get a copy of permission forms for your students from Toni Rapach.
- You should have students dropped off and picked up at either your home or the location you will be serving at – you should not be responsible for transporting your students.
- Remember, you make the final decision as to what type of service you will be doing as a class. You may want to get as many ideas as your students can come up with and then let them know what you have decided they will do. (It's difficult to get 10 people to agree on one idea, so teachers must make the final decision.) **Please do let me know what, when, and where your service project will be by returning the information form to me by TBD.**
- If I can help in your planning, let me know. If you need other adults to help you with your service project, please do not hesitate to ask me and/or to call some of the parents.
- Please let me know if you plan to do a 2nd semester Service Project as well! I just want to be able to brag about your class!
- Thank you for helping your class with their service commitment! I'm sure you will find the time you spend together doing service to be most rewarding! Have fun.
