### ***"We celebrate Easter: The Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ"***

If we have risen with Jesus then we too will be able to proclaim what we have seen, heard and touched from the beginning.

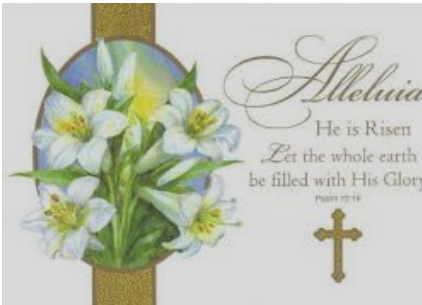
