Fr. Paul's Letter to our parishioners. April 30,2020

Dear Members of St. Boniface Church,

I'm so grateful for sending you my Easter season greetings, also to know how everybody is doing. For the "*Lord Is Indeed Risen Alleluia, Alleluia*" We are still in a time of real concerns and my highest priority and concern is the caring not only in a physical manner but more so in spiritual health and wellbeing of our parishioners. In this regard, I encourage all of you to keep taking appropriate steps to safeguard yourself against the Coronavirus. Take more precautions in social distancing, frequent hand washing with soap and sanitizer.

Unfortunately, we haven't been able to gather as a community to celebrate Holy mass and Eucharist with one another for more time to come. However, I still want to provide ways for you to continue growing in your spiritual life. Indeed, during this time in particular I hope that all of us will return even more to our Lord who always seeks to be very close to us. While you are not able to be present at Mass during this time, still you will be able to participate by watching masses on television or facebook or streaming on line. I will continue to celebrate the Eucharist privately and daily in church knowing that I am praying for you, for your loved ones and for myself. I then encourage everyone to read our bulletin weekly for updates. We will leave copies on the porch of the main entrance of church. Feel free to come get a copy. You can also find a copy on our website at saintboniface.net or St. Boniface facebook page.

Hours for the church be opened has changed for now. Tuesday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4 pm. This will give you an opportunity to come and visit and pray silently. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be in on Thursday's from 2 to 4 pm. There is a sign up sheet located inside the main entrance of church for you to sign up for a particular time you can come and visit. We must have at least one person there at all times. We are also encouraging ministers to help with setting out and putting back away the Blessed Sacrament. Also those handout prayers for adoration will be printed for every individual to keep. This will help to avoid sharing the same laminated handouts kept in the Sacristy, otherwise will need to sanitize every moment they are shared with. You will find that sign up on the same sheet. We can have up to 10 people in church at one time. Remember social distancing and to use the hand sanitizer!

My special prayers also to our Children and mostly those preparing for their First Communion, Confirmation and our Candidate to R.C.I.A. We haven't forgotten you and I am very sure and with the grace of God this event, the celebration of these Sacraments will happen very soon and solemnly in our Church. Praying also for all those affected by COVID-19 Pandemic and for those who have died and for their families. We are all in this together, stay strong and let us hold together in faith and in our community of St. Boniface Church. Very soon we will return in our communal celebration with our prayers and love. May our heavenly Mother, Blessed Virgin Mary and our Patron Saint Boniface whose feast day is (June 5th) pray for us all. Amen
