Dear brothers and sisters, *"God is good all the time!"*  
I am writing you this letter to bring you good news that after careful thought and prayerful discernment, the Archbishop has approved the plan for the limited reopening of Masses has gone into effect. The dispensation for the Sunday Mass obligation remains in effect, so no one is required or expected to attend Mass on the weekends with this reopening. Parishioners will have an expanded opportunity to attend Mass during the weekdays. Each Mass can be reopened to a maximum allowed **by law of 25 total people.**

**You must** sign up for Mass by calling or texting (Kim @ 503-949-9621), facebook messaging (Kim Zuber or St. Boniface) or email to the parish office [boniface@wvi.com](mailto:boniface@wvi.com). If you call the parish office to sign up, it must be only during office hours, do not leave a message.

**PLEASE DO NOT assume you can just come because you called, you must talk to Kim or receive a call, text or email back from the parish office or Kim.**

Unfortunately, those who simply show-up for Mass will be turned away. This is due largely to public health contact tracing requirements. First and Last name and contact number required for all attendees. Please also remember it will be easier to attend a weekday mass as not as many people will be able to come due to work.

**Limits on signing up:** Please be mindful of the other parishioners who want to also attend Mass. Large families of 7 or more, please limit to every other weekend.

**Rules that have been put in force per Archdiocese and government rules.** Please read these rules in your letter that you should have received by mail. They were mailed out on May 7th. If for some reason you did not receive your letter, please contact the parish office or stop by during regular business hours to pick one up.

**Weekday Mass times:** Wednesday-Thursday-Friday 9 am.

**Weekend Mass times:** Saturday 7pm, and Sunday 8 am & 10 am.

**Office Hours:** Tuesday-Friday 8 am-1 pm.

### *The Body and Blood of Christ, (Corpus Christi)*

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the most Holy Body and Blood of Christ that is the 'Eucharist'. Jesus chose the time of Passover to fulfill what he had announced at Capernaum – giving his disciples his body and his blood. Jesus' passing over to his Father by his death and resurrection, the new Passover, is anticipated in the last Supper and celebrated in the Lord's Supper, which fulfills the Jewish Passover and anticipates the final Passover of the Church in the glory of God's kingdom. This is the significant meal of Jesus. In this meal Jesus identifies the bread as his body and the cup as his blood. And so when he commands his disciples to eat his flesh and drink his blood, he invites us to take his life into the very center of our being. That life that he offers is very life of God himself. Jesus' death on the cross, his gift of his body and blood in the supper, and his promise to dine again with his disciples when the kingdom of God comes in all its fullness are inseparably linked. He also instructed his disciples to "do this in remembrance of me." These words establish each celebration of the Lord's Supper or Eucharist as a "remembrance" of Jesus' atoning death, his resurrection and his promise to return again. Our celebration of the Lord's Supper anticipates the final day when the Lord Jesus will feast anew with his disciples in the heavenly marriage feast of the lamb and his bride. When we receive the body and blood of Christ from the Lord's table we unite ourselves to Jesus Christ. We receive healing, pardon and rest for our souls.

Do we 'celebrate' the Eucharist knowing that it enables us to be firmly rooted in the love of Christ?
