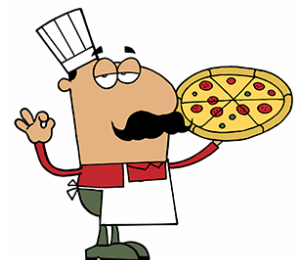
The Herrmann family continues to need our prayers and thank you for your continued support.
