### Academics

#### Religion

In Religion, we will continue to gain an understanding of the Seven Sacraments. Students will name and discuss the Sacraments of Initiation, Healing, and Service to Others.

#### Math

Students will find quotients of three and four digit dividends and will estimate quotients by using compatible numbers.

#### Reading/Language Arts

In reading, we will read *Hidden Worlds*. The students will summarize to aid in comprehension. Students will continue reading *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*. Pronouns will be introduced and applied to writing.

#### Science

Students will continue to learn about ecosystems; relationships and adaptation and survival.
