Academics

Religion

In Religion, we will gain an understanding of the gifts God gives us through the sacraments. Students will focus on the sacraments of Christian Initiation.

Math

Students will learn the properties of multiplication and find the products of whole numbers and money amounts. They will estimate the products using rounding.

Reading/Language Arts

In reading, we will read *Johanna in Jamaica* and *The Night of San Juan*. We will use problem/solution as a comprehension strategy. Words used as nouns and verbs will be learned. Writing skills will be practiced.

Science

Students will continue to explore Ecosystems; relationships in the system, adaptation and survival.
