On a daily basis the children will be practicing how to hold a writing instrument correctly while they write and draw pictures. When a child learns to color, they instinctively hold a crayon in their fist and scribble. But by now they should be able to properly hold their pencil between their thumb and pointer finger in the 'tripod grip'.

Have them practice writing their first AND last names on three-lined paper. Please have them use the lines. First letter is capitalized and the rest are lower-case.

Reinforcing school concepts at home not only contributes to learning and growth, but also help each child feel good about school while they share school experiences. Every month k we will be sending homework to reinforce concepts your child is learning in school.

Please read with your child every day! While reading look at the cover of the book and point out the title, author and illustrator of the book. Look at the picture on the cover and ask your child what she/he thinks the book will be about.
