We hope you enjoyed a very blessed Easter with your family.

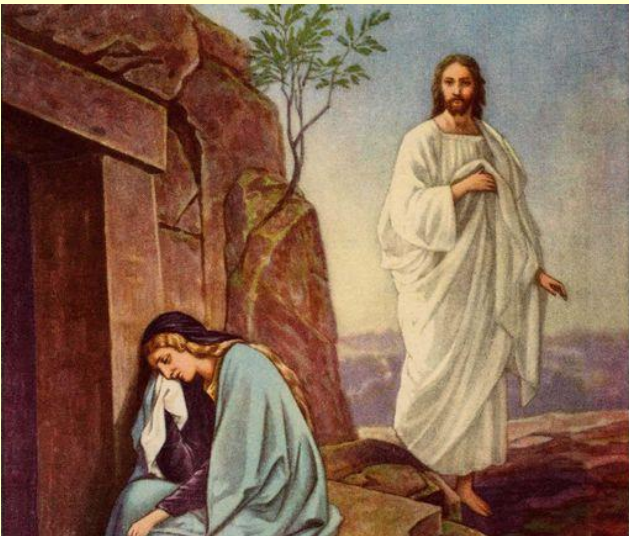
Mrs. Miranda and I continue to keep our fifth grade families in our prayers during this holy season of Easter and pray for your continued health and safety.
