



**St. Francis of Assisi Kindergarten
Supply List 2021-2022**

Please bring these items to open house or on the first day of school. It is important to note that some of these items are consumable and will need to be replenished throughout the year. Many of the consumable items will be collected and shared among students. Please do not label any of your child's supplies, unless otherwise noted. We ask for specific brands because some brands are poorer quality that may break easily, not sharpen well, or need to be replaced more often than the requested brands.

Quantity Item

- 1 **Large** capacity backpack, labeled with child's name **clearly written on the outside**. Must be large enough to hold lunch box, folders, and full-sized library books (approx. **Dimensions: 16.7" x 13" x 8.5"**) Fewer compartments recommended. Please, **NO** rolling backpacks (Must have a zipper, please **no** drawstrings or clips).
- 1 Lunchbox, labeled with child's name
- 1 Water bottle labeled with child's name
- 2 Packs Ticonderoga pencils sharpened
- 1 Pack Crayola Crayola Twistables crayons
- 2 Packs full-sized Crayola Twistable colored pencils 12 pack
- 1 Pack full-sized Crayola Twistable colored pencils 18 count
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks, large-size \
- 2 Pentel Hi-Polymer Erasers
- 2 Box (250 count each) Kleenex tissues
- 2 Clorox wipes—large container, for cleaning tables
- 1 Large roll of paper towels
- 1 Inexpensive (\$1-2) unisex item, wrapped, **no name**, for the birthday box (i.e.: coloring books, crayons, sidewalk chalk, etc. the Dollar Store is great!!!).
- 1 1" white binder to be used for your child's portfolio.

~We do not recommend RoseArt supplies, because they do not last as long or show true colors.

Please send an extra set of underwear, socks and a uniform (spills happen! —**name on all clothing**. Put in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it, to be kept in their book bag at ALL times.

Please **NO** toys or electronics. Stuffed animals are only permitted if they are part of a teacher request for a specific activity.

Remember to shop early, some items are quite popular!

Some Suggestions for Helping your Child Prepare for Kindergarten

- Your child should be comfortable speaking, and responding to adults.
- Be able to handle a backpack, lunchbox, sweater, and jacket.
- Be able to say their full name and address, and be in the process of memorizing their telephone number.
- Be able to hold and use pencils, crayons, markers, and scissors, correctly and successfully. They should be able to manage these items in a responsible way.
- Be able to listen to simple directions, and respond appropriately.
- Be able to interact positively in a group by using good manners, and kind words.
- **Be able to attend Mass with appropriate behavior, know simple prayers, and use the Sign of the Cross.**
- Be independent in the bathroom ,if you have a **son**, introduce them to urinals;
- Wash hands, blowing their nose, and using tissues appropriately.
