

4th Grade Lesson Plan for the Week 4 ~ 4/13-4/17

The following is the work you will need to work on this week. You should be working at least 3 days a week for about an hour or two. Please email Mrs. Kravet or Mrs. Daugherty if you have any questions.

Math:

- They must complete the 3 assignments in Freckle, which can be found by clicking on the assignments tab at the bottom of the screen. If they are struggling, they can watch the video on the left hand side next to the problem to hear an explanation. I will also post a video from Khan Academy to Google Classroom (math class) that they can use for extra help and practice. **The highest grade of the 3 fraction assignments will be counted as their grade for the week.**
- Instead of Xtra-Math this week, I have assigned fact practice through Freckle. This will show up under the assignments tab as Fact Practice and is on multiplication and division facts.. **This will also be graded.**

Science:

- They should continue working on the science assignments from last week, which are posted in Google Classroom (science class). **Both assignments are graded.** They are as follows:
 - ReadWorks article "Can the Amazon be Saved"
 - Endangered Animal Report - there are links on the second slide that they can use to research their chosen animal, but other resources may be used as well. The presentation should be filled in with the information specified on each slide.

Reading and Social Studies:

- There are two articles with questions on ReadWorks that will be assigned on Friday. **Both articles are graded.** They are due by Sunday, April 19th. Go to www.readworks.org. Click Student Login and sign in with your Google account. The class code is 77QYM3. Directions are also posted in the READING class on Google Classroom.
 - Reading Article: "Dead Zone"
 - Social Studies Article: "Colonization and Revolutionary War: Background to the Colonies"
- Students are still encouraged to go on Lexia, but it is not required this week.

English:

Students are to **choose ONE Funny Bunny Story Starter** and create their own story. Assignment and directions are posted in the READING class on Google Classroom.

Religion:

Students will read the pages about Easter and complete the four riddles. Assignment and directions are posted in the READING class on Google Classroom.
