10AM SUNDAY BILINGUAL OUTDOOR MASS

Dear Friends,

An outdoor bilingual Mass will be offered at 10am by the shady wooded area **behind the friary**. We are grateful for this option to worship together outside. Here are some specifics about how the Mass will be conducted.

- The Mass will be bilingual English & Spanish.
- It will be a simple joyful outdoor Mass with no choir/singing.
- This is a *'bring your own chair'* event (or feel free to stand).
- Mass will take place *rain or shine* (we will cancel if there is dangerous weather).
- There is very little shade and it can get quite hot so please bring a hat or umbrella, or whatever you will need to be comfortable (including, rain and sun protection). ***There are no bathrooms available.***
- Although it is an outdoor event, we will still have space limitations - ***we can accommodate approximately 150 households*** (people who live together) or individuals. When you arrive, you will find rows of squares marked out (7'x14' squares with 7'spaces between rows). One person/household per square. (Households with 4+ members may take two squares).
- Out of fairness, we cannot allow spaces to be saved for those who have not yet arrived.

SAFETY GUIDELINES: This is a time we are called to truly 'love our neighbors as ourselves'. We appreciate your support in keeping everyone safe by following these guidelines.

- Every person above the age of 2 years old ***must wear a mask*** (which covers both nose and mouth) from the time you leave your car (or enter the parking lot) until you return to it. Unfortunately, if you do not have a mask, you cannot attend the Mass.
- We will be practicing physical distancing to keep us all safe. Even when approaching the area, ***please leave at least 6 ft. between yourself and others.***
- Once you are in your spot, we ask that you remain there for the duration of the Mass. Families are reminded that children must stay at their parents' side at all times.
- We will not form lines for communion. During communion, Eucharistic ministers will pass through the empty space between rows to bring communion to those who wish to receive. We can only offer Eucharist in the hands (not on the tongue). Eucharistic ministers will be prepared with hand sanitizer in the event that they need to sanitize between communicants.
- We will not shake hands or hold hands during the Mass. We invite you to greet friends from a safe distance with a wave or a bow.
- After the Mass is over, we ask that you go directly to your cars. To facilitate everyone's safe exit from our worship space, we ask that you not stop to talk to others on the way out.

BE SURE YOU ARE HEALTHY: Before deciding to attend, please be sure that everyone is healthy:

- Take your temperature. Does anyone have a temperature above 100°? Has anyone had a temperature above 100 in the past week?
- Does anyone have body aches, shortness of breath, a persistent headache, chills or are otherwise feeling ill? Is anyone coughing or sneezing? (even if you believe it is allergies.)
- Has anyone been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?



If ANY of these conditions exist, please DO NOT attend in person but instead join us online.

We are all learning as we go, so some of our procedures will change as we learn from our experiences. Please be patient with us.
