



Instructions for attending public Masses at St. Camillus, beginning July 11-12:

1. Only the main (front) doors of the church will be open.
2. There will be no air conditioning so as not to re-circulate air.
3. Masks (covering nose and mouth) must be worn at all times, especially if you cough or sneeze! **No mask, no Mass!**
4. Social distancing of 6-feet must be observed at all times.
5. We will fill the pews beginning with the front pews and ending with the pews in the rear of the church.
6. Every other pew will be roped-off to prevent use and maintain social distancing.
7. Please follow the signs on the floors of those pews that are open. The signs are 6-feet apart.
8. Families and couples may sit together. However, 12 feet should be kept between such groups and the next person.
9. Please do not hold hands during the Our Father.
10. Please do not shake hands during the Sign of Peace. Please use a bow or a wave without any contact with others.
11. **Communion will be in the hand only. There will be no communion on the tongue during the pandemic.**
12. Please follow the arrows on the floor when coming to/returning from communion.
13. Please maintain 6-feet of social distancing on the communion line. There are signs on the floor indicating 6-foot intervals.
14. Please keep your masks on while in the communion line.
15. Communion is to be received in the hand only (not on the tongue) WITH YOUR MASK STILL ON. After receiving communion in the hand, please move three steps to the left or right (follow arrows on the floor), then lower your mask (without touching your face), consume the host, replace your mask (without touching your face), and return to your pew following the arrows on the floor.
16. Baskets for the weekly collection and donations will be found in the rear of the aisles. Please place your donations in the baskets when you leave. Thank you for your generous support of the parish.
17. We will depart from the church **beginning with the pews in the rear of the church** and continuing row by row until the first pew. Please maintain social distancing of 6-feet while leaving the church. Please keep your masks on at all times.
18. External doors will be open so that you do not need to touch them.
19. **All the bathrooms will be closed (as well as the St. Francis Room). Please do not drink a lot of liquids prior to coming to Mass! Please use the bathroom before you leave your home!**
20. There will be no holy water or hymnals. There will be no kneelers in front of the statues or the tabernacle.
21. Please use only the main (front) doors to enter and exit the church.
22. Please proceed directly to your car and do not congregate outside the doors.
23. Welcome to the "new normal." We do, most sincerely, want to welcome you back. But at the same time, we need to do all that we can do to keep each other safe. Let's take care of each other as we gather as the Body of Christ.
