At present, Nueces county is planning on using the parking area north of barns A & B (i.e. livestock barns), as well as the main entrance off of highway 77 and the baseball parking lot west of the fairgrounds as the staging for vaccinations on Tuesday, January 12th and Wednesday, January 13th. We encourage all exhibitors, guests, and volunteers to use the south fairground entrances off of East Main Avenue (Yes Blvd) throughout the show. The east entrance will be reserved for livestock events, while the west entrance should only be used for homemaking.
