Dear Exhibitors and Guests,

First, thank you for your patience as we finalize times, logistics, and protocols to hold our 86th Annual Jr. Livestock Show in the safest way possible and allow hundreds of young people the chance to exhibit and show their projects that they have worked so hard on.

Just a few last-minute reminders for exhibitors and their guests:

Wrist Bands: As a way to ensure social distancing and to keep capacity issues at a minimum, each exhibitor was issued one wrist band for themselves and two more for guests. We know this will come as an inconvenience to some, but please understand that we are doing our best to hold a safe show for our exhibitors, as well as the many volunteers. Wristbands will be checked at the entry points to the fairgrounds.

Masks: Masks should be worn at all times by committee members, exhibitors, and guests. In addition, there will be plenty of hand sanitizing stations through the facilities.

Logistics and County Vaccinations: The county will need use of some of the fairgrounds during our primary show week to administer COVID-19 vaccines. We are working with county officials to establish dates, times, and locations. It will not interfere with our show but could cause logistical constraints. In short, we will not have access to all entrances during some of the days of the show next week (Jan 11-16). Exhibitors, committee members, judges, etc. should plan on using the south entrances off East Main Avenue/Texas Yes Blvd. Please check our website and/or Facebook page later this week for a map.
