The group of approximately 40 travelers will begin our adventure with 3 days in the City of Florence, cradle of the Renaissance, with its famous churches, artwork, shopping and culinary delights.

Then it will be on to Tuscan wine country to see the hillside towns of San Gimignano and Siena, home of St. Catherine of Siena. Three days in Tuscany will include wine and cheese tasting and visits to Val D'Orcia, the "golden valley," with stops in the quaint towns of Montepulciano and Pienza. There will be a day trip to Perugia and Assisi, home of St. Francis and St. Claire.

We will depart Tuscan wine country and journey to the Eternal City, Rome, with a stop in the Umbrian town of Orvieto, known for its Etruscan ruins as well as its Gothic Cathedral.

We will spend 4 nights and 3 days in Rome visiting ancient Roman sites, the historical places of Christian Rome, the Vatican, the major basilicas, the catacombs, as well as a papal audience. Time will be time available to stroll the streets of Rome and enjoy the ambiance of this world-famous city.
