We have a secure link provided for us by Vanco Services that can be accessed from the homepage of our website: www.ourladyofangels.org. At the top of the homepage you will see **Online Giving**. Click that title and then click on Give Now at the bottom of the paragraph and you will be brought to the secure page. If you have not yet set up your profile for contributing, click on **Create Profile** in the right-hand column and you will be prompted step by step to provide the information needed to set up your contributing profile. After doing so, you use the Log In space at the top right of the Vanco page thereafter. You can make onetime donations to any parish or national collections or set up recurring contributions. If you have any questions, feel free to contact Fr. Monroe to discuss this process.

TD BANK AFFINITY PROGRAM

The parish has its account at TD Bank which offers nonprofit institutions an annual contribution from their corporate funds. Any parishioner who banks with TD can ask the bank to tag their accounts indicating your membership with Our Lady of the Angels. None of your money is ever touched. Once a year, we receive a check from TD Bank that represents a percentage of the total funds in checking, savings and CD accounts that are tagged for OLA. In April, we received our annual dividend of **\$1,235.45**. The money was deposited in our Maintenance Fund, helping to defray some of our winter expenses. We encourage those who have TD Bank accounts to speak with one of the desk clerks and have your accounts tagged. We also receive a bonus amount for any parishioner who opens a new account with TD Bank.

ADULT FORMATION

Are you someone or do you know someone who has expressed an interest in becoming Catholic? Do you know someone who has a child over the age of seven who has not been baptized or was baptized in the Catholic Church as a child, but has not celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist?

We offer an opportunity to come together in a small group to learn more about our faith. Sessions focus on the teachings and experience of Church and prepare individuals to celebrate the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist during the Easter season. HOSPITAL VISITS

Father Monroe regularly visits area hospitals to bring the spiritual support of the parish to those who are ill. St. Vincent Hospital has a process to ask people who are admitted if they have a religious connection and parish. Fr. Monroe is then given those names when he calls and gives our parish code. UMass-Memorial Hospital is no longer providing that information to churches so unless a family member of the patient calls to let us know of his/her hospitalization, we have no way of knowing he/she is there. We encourage family to alert us to a loved one's admission to those hospitals so that Fr. Monroe can offer the Church's presence and sacramental help.

MONTHLY HOME VISITS

Fr. Monroe, Sr. Marie Therese and several of our Communion Ministers rotate lists of homebound parishioners and those who are in rehab, assisted living or long-term care facilities to bring them Communion and the prayerful support of the parish.
