**DO YOU KNOW OF ANYONE
INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a program for adults who desire to become fully initiated members of the Catholic Church. It's goal of the RCIA process is full, conscious and active participation in an exciting life with Jesus Christ within His Catholic Church. RCIA helps adults grow in their relationship with God, become familiar with Catholic teachings and practices, get acquainted with the faith community and get involved in service within the community. Many people who want to join the Catholic Church have already been baptized in another Christian Church. They do not need to be rebaptized. They participate in the process with those never baptized to familiarize themselves with the Roman Catholic Tradition. Others may have been baptized in the Catholic Church and need to complete the sacraments of initiation by receiving first Eucharist and/or Confirmation. All will have an opportunity to grow in their relationship with God and learn more about the faith before receiving the Sacraments. TD BANK --AFFINITY PROGRAM

Our parish has its account with TD Bank which offers a wonderful non-profit benefit to customers like us. They allow members of the parish who have accounts at the bank to consider having their savings or cd accounts tagged indicating your membership in the parish. On an annual basis, the TD Bank Corporation donates 1/10th of one percent of the average daily balances of all tagged savings accounts and certificates of deposit. Fr. Monroe has his personal accounts at the bank and has his account tagged and a significant number of households have done so as well, resulting in a check for \$1,235.45 to the parish in fiscal year 2018. If any existing bank customer who is not yet participating decides to do so, we receive \$10 for each person who does so and \$50 for anyone who opens a new account at TD Bank and asked to have that savings or certificate of deposit account tagged. LEGACY OF HOPE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

I have met with our Finance Committee and Jon van Beaver of Guidance in Giving who will be our parish's guide and support to undertake the capital campaign. As I mentioned a few weeks ago, Bishop McManus has asked all parishes to be part of this effort to build up endowments for various diocesan needs and provide parishes with funds to undertake necessary projects, pay off debts and set money aside for future needs. Forty percent of every dollar raised will be returned to the parish and the other sixty percent will fund the diocesan needs.

Our parish appeal will take place during the Fall months. Right now, we are trying to set up various committees to do the appeal. Parishioners will be invited to one of several receptions that will be held in the Rieger Hall to present the scope and purpose of the appeal and hand out pledge materials.
