Thank you to all parishioners who responded to Fr. Monroe’s letter inviting them to informational receptions on October 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. These four gatherings followed another one held on September 16<sup>th</sup> for a small group of parishioners asked to form the lead group for our effort.

Please note that 60% of what we raise goes to fund the diocesan needs and 40% will be returned to OLA on a quarterly basis beginning in June of 2020.

As of this bulletin going to press, we have raised \$116,920 for the effort to solidify endowments for diocesan need and parish needs - \$70,152 for diocesan needs and \$46,768 coming back to our parish as people pay their pledges.

This weekend, we will present a brief video at the beginning of Mass to help people unable to attend the receptions conceptualize the purpose of the Appeal. Members of the Committee will speak briefly at the beginning of Masses next weekend and on the weekend of October 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> Fr. Monroe will be inviting everyone to make a commitment to offer what they prayerfully think they might be able to offer over the next 4 years.
