Financial Report

Through our fundraising efforts of last year, we brought in about \$23,500. This is an increase of about \$7000 from the previous year. We would like to raise the same amount this year, or closer to \$25,000. This averages out to about \$95/student. Major expenses for the 2019-2020 school year so far include us buying \$3000 of extra iPads for the 4th & 5th grades to account for their larger class size. This allows every student to have an iPad in the classroom. FSA also loaned the Athletic Association \$2500 to purchase mirrors for the new Cheer room. This will be repaid by cheer fees and coach stipends over a two year period.

The money raised from FSA will be going to facility improvements around campus. Just an idea of some improvement costs. The A/C in the Kindergarten wing when out at the beginning of the year. This is a \$20K expense for the school. The canopy we put up in front of the gym last year was \$15K. Windows need to be replaced outside of 4th and 5th grade along with the windows on the south side of the Media Center.

Spirit Shirts. We have sold 297 spirit shirts and raised almost \$1000 for the school. We will be printing one more round of shirts. Orders are due September 23rd.
