Financial Report

Through our fundraising efforts of last year, we brought in about \$18,000. This was about \$5000 less than the previous year. We missed a few events at the end of the year, but we are ready to start strong for 2020. Our uniform sales and spirit shirts have brought in about \$3000. FSA purchased face shields for all staff and purchased a projector for Mrs Valot's room to accommodate her larger class. The money raised from FSA will be going to facility improvements around campus.

New Business

Spirit Shirts. They will be delivered the week of Sept 21st. I have a few extras if you still need to order one.

Day of Service. September 19th, 8am-noon. Protecting God's Children is not required for this event. Most of our projects are beautification projects or they deal with getting our stem projects ready for the classroom.

2nd Annual Ravens Run. This is our BIG fundraiser for the Fall. It is scheduled for November 20th starting at 8am. Our goal for the fundraiser is \$8500. We are hoping that each student can raise a minimum of \$40. We

have lots of fun incentives and prizes for the kids to get them excited! We are currently looking for businesses to sponsor our event and to be listed on the back of the t-shirt. The three levels of sponsorship are \$300, \$150, and \$50. You will see more info in the blue folder soon!

Trunk or Treat. October 30th. 5:30-7:30pm. This is our most popular event of the year! Typically, we have games in the courtyard and the kids start Trunk or Treating around 7pm. We will need people to sign up to decorate their trunk and to help with the planning of the event. We want to make sure that this is a safe and memorable event for our students! At this time, there are no plans for a middle school dance.

Science Fair. Our middle school students will be participating in Science Fair on December 3rd. We are looking for volunteers to setup breakfast and/or lunch, judge the projects, and take photos. If you are interested, email kyspeakes@yahoo.com.

Poker Night. Currently postponed to the Spring. This is usually a night out at Best Bet. Last year we raised about \$18,000. We would love to do this again!

SCRIP. SCRIP is an easy fundraising tool that gives money back to our school AND you. Through SCRIP purchases, you buy gift cards for stores that you usually shop at like Wal-Mart, Publix and many, many more. You only pay the face value of the card and then the retailers donate a percentage of the gift card value to our school.

For example, CVS donates 7% to CTK. For a \$25 gift card, that is \$1.75. The school splits that amount with you, so that you can then use it toward academic fees/tuition the next school year. Cards can be purchased on the SCRIP website or you can make a request with the weekly blue folder.

Volunteer Hours. All parents are responsible for entering their own hours after completing a service activity. Just a reminder, you have 30 days to enter your hours from the date of service. The form is on our website at ctkschooljax.com under the Parents tab.

BoxTops. All Boxtops are due October 19th. Please turn in your clipped Boxtops marked with your grade. As a reminder, clipped BoxTops are slowly being phased out but are still accepted. They are moving everything to a mobile platform where you just need to scan your receipts. Download the app and start using it today!
