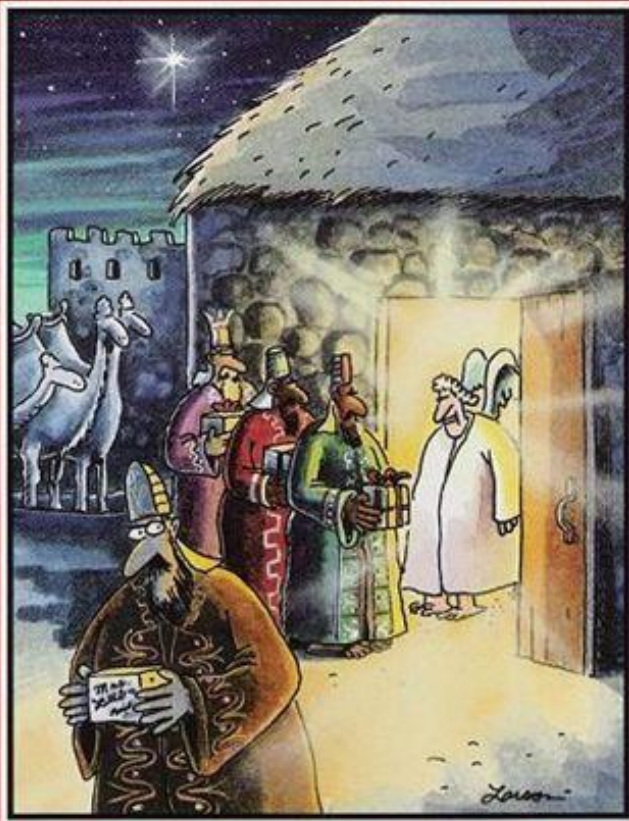

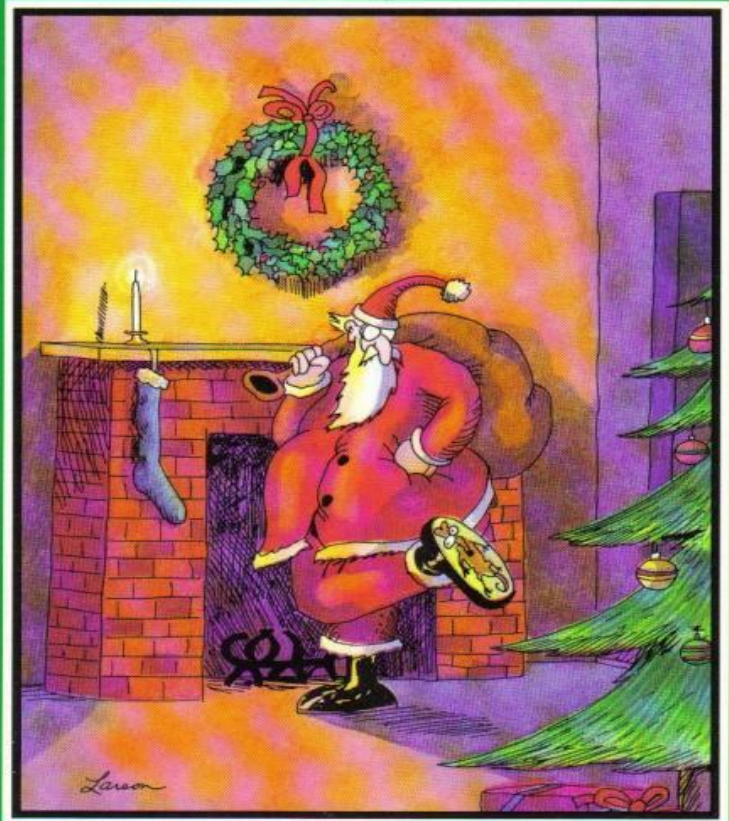
News from the Scribe
