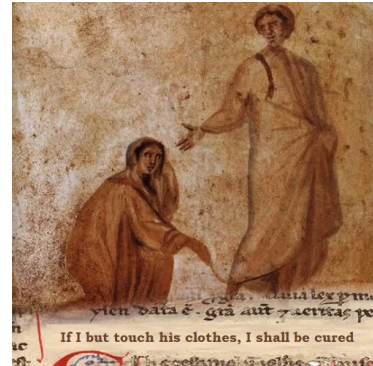

This Sacrament is available for individuals upon request, and communal celebrations are periodically scheduled.

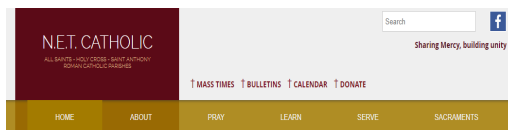
Ministry to the Sick

Through the summer we will be discerning among the ministry team and with catechists and parents how we can best improve our faith formation programs to offer all ages a way to come to better know God. The serve section will provide you with information on all the ways we serve the Lord by serving others, especially the poor. This will make it possible for you to join in one of this many services or to request a service for yourself.
