**A Little Bit About Me**

My name is Dawn Burdick. I grew up in Wyoming County, in a little town called Bliss, near Letchworth State Park. My father, a Marine Vietnam Veteran, was an over-the-road truck driver, and my mom was a preschool teacher. I have a younger brother and sister, who both live out of state with their families. My dad went home to God a few years ago, but I am sure you will meet my mom at some point, as she graciously agrees to help me with all sorts of projects. I am not married and have no children of my own, but love being Auntie Dawn to my young nieces and nephews, whenever I have the chance.



My first "real" job was working for a payroll company in the Rochester area, and while I liked certain aspects of the work, I always felt like something was missing. In the summer of 2000, I decided to leave that job and spend some time trying to figure out where God wanted me to go (I look back on that now and think about how brave I must have been to do that - I guess that's one of the benefits of being in your early 20s). At church one weekend during that time, an announcement was made that they needed someone to fill in for a few weeks for the youth minister, who was about to have a baby. I decided that since I had the time, I could volunteer for that, thinking that I probably had a lot I could offer the teens. So I went that first Sunday night and quickly realized I had very little to offer them, short of a listening ear and caring heart, but they had a lifetime of lessons I could learn from them. Thus began my time in pastoral ministry, as the previous youth minister decided to turn over the reigns so that she could spend more time with her family. In the following eighteen years, I have had the unbelievable privilege to minister not only to, with, for, and by young people, but with people of every age, becoming a Pastoral Associate about five years ago. I have had wonderful mentors, guides and friends along the way, including Fr. Daniel, and I am thrilled to have the chance to work with him once again.

Recently, my six-year-old nephew asked me to explain what I did as a job. Trying to put it in a kid-friendly way, I ended up telling him that my job is to help provide opportunities for people to encounter God, and to help them respond to God's invitation, whatever that may be. I'm not sure that he understood, but it is both at the core of who I am, and what I hope to do.

I am excited to get to know each of you, and the three communities our parishes are part of. Being new to the area, if you have any advice for me, I'm all ears!

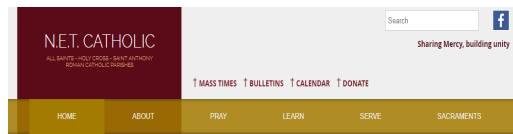
