FATHER DANIEL . . .**

Update on Faith Formation



Thank you all for your input on our faith formation programs. Through our listening sessions with catechists and parents and our survey, we heard from most of the catechists and 50 households with children, which correspond to 90% of our parents. We have also discussed this with our pastoral councils at each parish.

Our catechists love their ministry and are eager to find better ways to help our children learn their faith and come into a personal relationship with Christ. They suggested that having a clear sense of what should be taught in each grade and how each grade builds on the previous year and prepares for the next might be helpful. They also asked to be provided with some resources and formation. They emphasized the importance of rituals, teaching children how to pray and offering parents an opportunity for community, discussion and learning.

I will summarize the feedback we received from our parents in six desires: A desire to know what is being taught so they can discuss it with their children, a desire to have some guidance and ready resources they can use with their children, a desire for children to be able to socialize and share their faith in bigger groups, a desire for more opportunities for community among adults, a desire to be able to learn more and to discuss faith in ways that are relevant to adults, and a desire to keep faith formation linked to Mass so it is only one trip a week to church.

After we received our feedback, we have been hard at work with Dawn Burdick and our catechists to put a program together that will build upon all the great things that are already happening and respond to the needs that both parents and catechists have expressed.

In the next couple weeks, every household in our parish will be receiving a mailing with information on our new faith formation program and an invitation to register. This mailing will include the dates for our faith formation program for the whole year so you can put them into your calendar early and know what to expect. Our new program will include parishioners of all ages. On August 18-19, after you have received your mailing, I will be preaching about the program, and we will have a coffee hour after every Mass to present the program and answer questions. On August 26, Dawn and some of our catechists will talk to the community about the program during our weekend Masses, and finally on September 8 and 9 we will have our Sign Up Sunday Coffee Hour after all the Masses with an opportunity to register for those who have not done it. I do encourage you to register as soon as you get your mailing so that we can plan ahead.

The Holy Spirit has been guiding us and we are very excited. We think we will be able to offer an even greater program so that we can all continue to grow in faith together. Please stay tuned and in the meantime feel free to approach, call, email, etc. Dawn and me with any questions, feedback or comments you want to offer.
