FATHER DANIEL . . .**

**Give yourself the opportunity to be set free by
God's Mercy this Lent**

When we have a physical wound, we must clean it so that it can heal and so that it does not get infected. Cleaning a wound is not a pleasant experience but it is necessary. We also need to attend to our spiritual wounds, knots and sins, or our pain will fester into anger or other behaviors that will hurt us and others. The Sacrament of Confession is the place where we attend to our spiritual wounds; we allow God to cleanse us so we can be healed.

Going to Confession is not easy—it forces us to reflect on the parts of our life that we sometimes try to ignore. It might be a little embarrassing to share our sins with the priest, etc., yet once we do it, we feel like a burden has been lifted. Every step of the process is designed to help us heal, to set us free from all the things that imprison us and make us suffer, to restore us to the joy and freedom of knowing that we are unconditionally loved and always forgiven by God, who gives us the grace to be better.

This Lent, we will offer many opportunities to experience this beautiful freedom of the children of God; plan to celebrate Confession this Lent, plan to bring your children to confession.

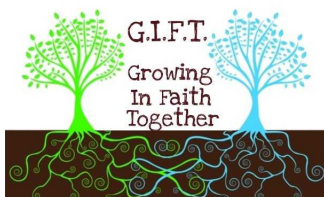
