I am so grateful that Bishop Clark has accepted the invitation to come and share his presence and wisdom with us! Next weekend we will have the great privilege of welcoming Bishop Matthew Clark to our parishes for our Lenten Mission. He will also **preside and preach at our 10:30 am (All Saints), and 2:00 pm (Saint Anthony) Masses on Sunday, March 31. If you can adjust your schedule and attend one of these two Masses next weekend, please do so.**

Do not miss this opportunity to attend our Lenten Mission with him. Invite your friends and neighbors—it does not matter what parish they belong to or if they are Catholic or not. Each evening we will have a simple reception after the talk so that all have an opportunity to greet Bishop Clark and converse with him.


Bishop Clark was born on July 15, 1937, in Waterford, NY. He was ordained a priest in Rome in 1962. He holds a Licentiate in Theology and a Licentiate in Canon Law from the Gregorian University in Rome. In 1979, he was ordained a Bishop in St. Peter's Basilica, Rome, by Saint Pope John Paul II. On June 26, 1979, he was installed as eighth Bishop of the Diocese of Rochester. He retired almost 34 years later.
