A NOTE FROM FATHER DANIEL . . .

Our unity in and through the Most Holy Eucharist

In his last prayer to the Father, Jesus prayed that we might be one. At Mass we always pray : **grant that we, who are nourished by the Body and Blood of your Son and filled with his Holy Spirit, may become one body, one spirit in Christ.**

This unity that is built through this Most Sacred Sacrament is preserved in the Church by the Pope, the Bishops and the Priests as we all journey in the unity of faith.

The unity of the priests with their Bishop is clearly seen in our obedience to the Bishop and our union with him in our teaching and celebration of the Sacraments. This unity is beautifully celebrated each year at the Chrism Mass, during Holy Week when all the priests in a diocese gather with their bishop and renew their priestly promises during the celebration of Mass. This union is also celebrated when all the priests in the diocese get together with the Bishop once a year for convocation. A few days to rest, learn, and be with each other.

This year our Convocation will be in Corning, May 13-15. During those three days, I will be away and we will have no Masses or Confessions, yet I will certainly be praying for you and I ask that you pray for me, for my brother priests and for our Bishop that these days will be fruitful as we gather during difficult times.

The same unity that we celebrate in the Eucharist, means that the Church is Catholic (this means universal) and that we are all brother and sisters.

As brothers and sisters, we are responsible for one another, especially for the weakest members of the Body of Christ, among whom are the materially poor.

I thank you for all your continued charitable works in this world that make this unity of the Body of Christ and our love for the poor so very present and real.

I commend you for the donations you might have made to different organizations that help the poor with the fruits of your Lenten penance and almsgiving.

In this spirit of fraternal care for the poor, I will be going to the Dominican Republic May 20-24 to visit the ministries that Fr. Ron Gaesser has established there and to see how we can support him and our sisters and brothers he so generously serves.

While I am in the Dominican Republic, there will be no Masses or Confessions either, but there will be a Word and Communion Service Tuesday at Saint Anthony, Wednesday at Holy Cross, and Thursday at All Saints.

Since, I will only be away during weekdays, our weekend Mass schedule will remain the same.
