

Chocolate Spoons

These can be used as small gifts to add a little chocolate into someone's coffee or to strengthen the recipient's hot chocolate.

Here is what you will need:

- 24 plastic spoons
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup milk chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup white chocolate chips
- sandwich baggies (without zippers)
- thin ribbon cut into 3" pieces
- wax paper on cookie sheets or pieces of cardboard

In a microwave-safe bowl, melt the semisweet chocolate chips for 2 minutes. Stir until smooth. (If the chocolate is not warm enough, microwave in 20 second intervals until it can be stirred smooth.) Do not overcook.

Dip the rounded end of the spoon in the chocolate. Put spoons onto wax paper and refrigerate until chocolate hardens.

Melt the milk chocolate pieces in the microwave for 2 minutes and stir until smooth. Place chocolate into a plastic bag and cut off the corner. Do the same with white chocolate.

Drizzle melted chocolate over the spoons to decorate. Refrigerate until chocolate hardens.

Wrap the spoons individually by putting the chocolate end of the spoon into a baggie and tying it with a ribbon.
