

# iXL Summer Information



Dear Students:

As we prepare for the summer break, we want to share our expectations for your iXL summer work. All students completing grades K–7 will log on and fully complete a minimum of 4 out of 5 sessions. Each two week session contains both MATH and READING/WRITING topics. You will receive credit for each properly completed session in both your MATH and WRITING classes come September. The summer study session represents the first test grade for the 2019–2020 school year.

## TO LOG-IN TO iXL:

1. Log in to [www.ixl.com/signin/paterson](http://www.ixl.com/signin/paterson)
2. On the Welcome screen, enter your student username and password
3. Select Math or Language Arts
4. On the left hand margin, Identify the letter, grade, and topics for each session (posted in Google Classroom).
5. Practice away!

## STUDENT PROGRAM NOTES

1. The summer program will run for 5 two-week sessions. Students are required to complete 4 of the 5 sessions.
2. Students are assigned five math and three reading/writing topics per session.
3. Refer to Google Classroom at the beginning of each session to retrieve the new topics. The program allows students to work at their own pace and improve individually. While you may work on any topic at any time, we must ask that you focus on certain indicated topics at specific times throughout the summer.
4. Students are expected to practice in the iXL program for two hours during each session. They should strive to earn a SMART SCORE of 80% on each topic. SMART SCORES increase with consistency in correct answer choices.
5. The time spent practicing, questions attempted, and individual 'smart scores' will be recorded at the completion of each session. If you have been working on a specific skill for more than **20 minutes**; stop and email either Ms. Alpaugh or Mrs. Gonzalez.
6. Extra credit will be given for completing all 5 sessions.
