Pastor Report: From Father Bob via email

- 1) We had first communion - only a 1/3 of our students participated this year, making us one of the lowest attended parishes in the diocese.
- 2) There are new windows installed in De Padua cafeteria, the concrete will be repaired behind the school leading to the church, and new security system with card keys will be installed and formed with our fire system, all under the umbrella of Korsen. This is phase one, while next phases will be the rest of the parish buildings.
- 3) There needs to be thoughts of how to build up the SGO, this is a very high priority. I still suggest a gold outing or wine and cheese event.

Principal Report: Karen Bogol

- Enrollment is currently at 245
- Two committees are currently in place to plan for the 2020-2021 school year:
 1. Curriculum Committee
 - The school advisory council will review the surveys regarding remote learning and provide feedback to the curriculum committee.
 2. COVID Committee
 - The committee is still waiting on guidelines and required procedures from the diocese.
 - The requested CARES money will be used to provide additional chrome books (1:1 for grades 3-8 with computer security system installed), hand sanitizing bottles throughout the building, water bottle fillers installed in the water fountains. If extra money is available, tablets will be bought for the lower grades.

Advisory Council Discussions:

- The advisory board supports hiring the licensed library/computer science teacher to support the school in various ways.
- The advisory council supports the idea to explore foreign language opportunities. The council discussed offering Latin or offering a variety of languages to allow students to

gain exposure prior to high school. Karen plans to reach out to Marian and St. Joseph principals and/or ND ACE.

- Diego Padilla has resigned from the council. The council is currently looking for two additional members to serve. A marketing background would be beneficial.
