Pastor's Report: Father Ben

- There will be a significant parishioner tuition increase for the 2021-2022 school year. Families will have the opportunity to ask Father Ben for pastoral support. This tuition increase will provide an increase in teacher salary, an increase for teacher retirement, and help to benefit our entire school budget.

Principal's Report: Karen

- The Junior High has returned to school.
- The teachers continue to be amazing teaching both in-person and remote learners (about 15% are remote learning).
- It is unlikely the school will offer a virtual learning option next fall 2021. More information will be given to families soon.
- SGO - the amount need has been met. Both new and past donors contributed to this success!
- The school plans to continue building upon what already exists. 25 kids per class is the approximate class size goal. Existing grade levels with two classes will continue as two classes.
- Teacher PD- federal funds are being used for technology as well as to assist teachers in analyzing testing data to support student learning.
- Catholic Schools Week- kick off is Sunday, January 31. Karen will speak at the 10:30 Mass. School Board members are asked to greet at the back of church and/or give school tours. Please email Karen directly if you are available.
