Discounts, Tuition Assistance, and Payment Plan Offerings

We are committed to developing a partnership with families seeking a faith-based education. Because we know your choice in a Catholic school involves financial sacrifice, we do offer participation in several programs to ensure our school is affordable and accessible.

Parish Subsidy Discount

Active parishioners of St. Anthony Parish, as well as those who are members of a sending parish (without a school), may receive a parish subsidy discount on the cost to educate children at St. Anthony School. If you are Catholic and interested in joining our parish to receive this discount, please contact Pam White at pwhite@stasb.org or 233-7169. Mass attendance and participation from the previous year are evaluated each year through a signed *Active Parishioner Affidavit* form.

Grade K-8 Tuition Assistance

- **School Choice Scholarships** - Scholarships are issued by the State of Indiana, but processed at St. Anthony using state defined household eligibility factors.
- **SGO Grants** – SGO Grants are offered by our Diocese for those with Household Adjusted Gross Income at or below 200% of Reduced Lunch Eligibility (see 200% column on “Choice Scholarship Program Household Income Limits”). SGO Grants potentially provide a pathway into the scholarship program in the subsequent school year, if income eligibility is met. SGO Grant can be awarded in conjunction with a School Choice Scholarship.
- **Active Parishioner Scholarships** - St. Anthony Parish is happy to award Pastoral Scholarships to assist active parish families who are interested in assistance. **Parish families are strongly encouraged to apply**, regardless of household income.
- **Large Family Fund** – Offered by the Diocese to families with 3 or more children enrolled in Catholic schools.

K-8 Tuition Assistance Request Process & Award Amounts

All assistance requests begin with a [FACTS Grant & Aid](#) application for household data verification purposes and are submitted online at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FFKJ>. Additional paperwork may also be requested/required. Applications for assistance are reviewed **after a student has completed the registration process and has been accepted for enrollment**. The deadline for submitting Grant & Aid applications for the upcoming school year is April 15. Aid determinations are made and communicated to families on/around May 15. Families enrolled after these dates are considered on a case-by-case basis, as enrollment is granted.

Assistance award amounts are specific to each family and may vary by household factors. We are glad to work with you to determine award eligibility and amounts for the various awards.

Pre-K Tuition Assistance

Assistance for Pre-K is in the form of **Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) Vouchers** and are issued through the CCDF program via an appointment with an intake officer. Please visit <https://inchildcare.org/> for additional information.

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Convenient Tuition & Fee Payment Options

- Tuition may be paid in full by June 15, over 10 months from July to April, or over 12 months from July to June.
- [FACTS Payment Plan setup](#) - Payments are processed through our FACTS Payment Plan system. You have the option of setting up a full pay, 12-month (July-June), or a 10-month payment plan (Sept.-June).
- Payment Plan setup is completed online in the FACTS system at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3FFKJ> and must be completed at the time of enrollment. **Enrollment applications are processed after FACTS setup is finalized.**
- A non-refundable Enrollment Fee for 2021-22 will be charged at the rate of \$150 per child or \$200 per family. This fee is paid outside of tuition, tuition assistance, and School Choice. Payment of this fee will secure your child's placement at St. Anthony de Padua Catholic School and will be assessed through FACTS at the time of enrollment. The enrollment fee will only be refunded if admission is denied by St. Anthony School.

Additional Financial Information

- **Payment Upon Withdrawal or Transfer** -All fees are due and payable in full at the time of withdrawal or transfer to another school, unless sufficient payment has been made to cover the fees amount. Any remaining fees and tuition will be prorated based upon 180 days of school from the first day of attendance to the last day of attendance. Payment of any balance owed to St. Anthony is required for future acceptance into another Diocesan school, including high school, and for the transfer of student records to any public or private school.
