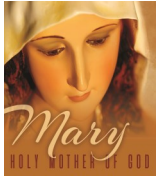
PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL SPONSORED

ROSARY DEVOTION TO OUR BLESSED MOTHER.



May is the month dedicated to praying the rosary in honor of our Blessed Mother. The origin of the Rosary dates back to St. Dominic, when our Blessed Lady appeared to him and asked him to teach the people how to pray the Rosary (1208). Since then it has become a world wide devotion and saints like St. Padre Pio have called this devotion of the Rosary, “the greatest weapon against Satan.” Here at Sacred Heart we continue this family tradition of teaching and praying the Rosary. We invite everyone, especially families, to come and join us in keeping the Blessed Mother’s request to pray the rosary daily. Our devotion will take place on the following dates: **Wednesday evenings, May 23rd & 30th.** All devotions will start at **7:00 PM** in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, and will include Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
