Please remove all winter decorations from the cemetery by March 18th. Lot owners and families are reminded that the rules and regulations are posted at the rotary. Please refer to these signs.

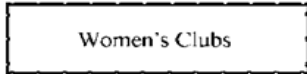
There will not be a meeting of the Prayer Shawl and Rosary beads ministries on Wednesday, March 6th, due to Ash Wednesday.
