**First Friday** April 5th is the **First Friday** of the **month**, and is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. As is our tradition here at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish our day begins with the celebration of **Mass at 7AM.** in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. At **12 NOON** the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is prayed and **Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will be celebrated.** All are invited to come anytime during these hours for spiritual enrichment and personal time with Jesus. **We especially encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS as part of your spiritual development.** Following morning Mass the Sacrament of Reconciliation may be requested by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from 8 AM to 3 PM each day at the rectory by appointment. During the Winter months the First Friday evening devotion is suspended until the First Friday of May, 2018. **“Come to Me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest” Matthew 11:28.**

### DAILY BREAD FOOD PANTRY

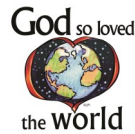
