The Heart of Jesus beacons all sinners to immerse themselves into His ocean of love that is found in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Let us begin this month by making all things right between God and ourselves by trusting in the Divine Mercy of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. **First Friday (June 7<sup>th</sup>), Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 AM followed by Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 noon.** Come and spend some time during these hours before the REAL PRESENCE of Jesus and unload the heavy burdens that you are carrying in life. **MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT NOW!** He is waiting for your visit. The Rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour starting at 7:30 AM. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed at 12 noon followed by Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
