Friday, July 5, 2019 is the First Friday of the month. We remember the great gift of love that Jesus gave us through the shedding of His Precious Blood through His Passion and Death on the Cross. Once again we continue our tradition here at Sacred Heart Parish by celebrating our monthly devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our day will begin with the celebration of **Mass at 7:00 AM in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph**, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 noon. The Rosary will be prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. As we celebrate our nation's 243rd year of independence, perhaps it might be wise to come and thank Him for giving us a land to celebrate our God given Freedoms. **At 12 noon, The Chaplet of Divine Mercy** will be celebrated along with **Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament**. The Sacrament of Penance is available each morning after the 7 AM Mass, as well as the regular time on Saturday afternoon, and during office hours at the rectory.
