OCTOBER – DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS
Friday, October 4, 2019 is the First Friday of the month. We are reminded of the great gift of love that Jesus gave us through the shedding of His Precious

Blood in His Passion and Death on the Cross. Once again we continue our tradition at Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish by celebrating our monthly devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our day will begin with the celebration of **Mass at 7:00 AM in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph**, followed by exposition and adoration of the **REAL PRESENCE of JESUS** in the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 noon. The rosary will be prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. All are invited to take a few minutes from your busy schedule to spend some time in personal prayer with Jesus during these hours. At **12 noon**, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed followed by Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, bringing our devotion to a close. The Sacrament of Penance is available each morning after the 7 AM Mass, as well as during the regular office hours or by appointment in the rectory, or the regular hours on Saturday afternoon in the upper church.

The rosary is prayed each weekday morning after the 7:00 a.m. Mass. All are welcome.
