**OCTOBER FAMILY ROSARY DEVOTION (2019)**

On September 7, 2013, the vigil of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Holy Father Pope Francis made a plea to the whole Church to set apart time for prayer through the intercession of Mary, our heavenly Mother and Mother of the Church, to pray for peace. The world was on the verge of war. An eyewitness from our own parish was among the 100,000 who gathered in St. Peter's Square with the Pope to pray the Rosary, chant the Litany to Our Lady, listen to the guidance of the Pope to read the Sacred Scriptures and pray before the Blessed Sacrament. It was four hours in perfect reverence, silence and meditation. The Service concluded with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The world did not go to war. The media attributed the outcome to the Russian President. Do you think that the prayers of the Church, through the intercession of our Blessed Mother, had anything to do with this miracle? On **Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup>** at **7:00 PM** we will mark the mid-point of our October Family Devotion to Mary, our heavenly Mother. Our crisis this year is for the unification and conversion of all families back to the Faith of the Church. What is the crisis in your life that needs healing? Are we humble enough and is our faith strong enough to place ourselves at the feet of Mary, our mother, to ask for her assistance to grant you a miracle? Bring yourself and your family this Wednesday and the remaining Wednesdays in October to this devotion. At 7PM we will gather in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph to pray the rosary, the Litany of our Blessed Mother and worship her Son, Jesus, with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Light refreshments will be served in the Chapel Room each night following the devotion.

**The rosary is prayed each weekday morning after the 7:00 a.m. Mass. All are welcome.**
