ALL SOULS DAY, NOVEMBER 2ND.

Monday, November 2nd, is All Souls Day. On this day we pray for all our deceased members of our parish family and we also begin our 9 day Novena of Masses for all those who died in our parish over the past year. The names of these deceased will be read after the 7AM Mass, celebrated in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, and will be displayed throughout the month of November in a book placed in front of the pulpit. Please join us during this Novena and during this month dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Friday, November 6, 2020, is the First Friday of the month. Traditionally, in our parish, every First Friday of the month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our day begins with the celebration of **Mass at 7AM**, in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. **At 12 NOON. Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.** All are invited to come anytime during these hours for spiritual enrichment and personal time with Jesus. **We encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS** as part of their spiritual development. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus also serves as a reminder for one to receive the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). The Sacrament of Reconciliation may also be requested any day following morning Mass by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from 8 AM to 3 PM weekdays (except Thursday) at the rectory or by appointment. Saturday confessions are scheduled 3-3:30 PM in the upper church. **ALL REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO COVID 19 MUST BE FOLLOWED. MASKS MUST BE WORN AND DISTANCING MUST BE OBSERVED.**
