## FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings! This weekend we celebrate the 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time and begin hearing again from the *Gospel of Mark*. Jesus speaks today about the importance of cleansing our hearts from evil, keeping guard over our interior life and not just externals. God desires a pure heart that humbly welcomes his word, and ears open to obedience, ready to be doers of his word and not hearers only. May our reception today of Jesus in his word and the Eucharist spur us on to faith-filled action.

Please pray for *Sheila Thornton*, whose funeral was here last week, and for *Matthew Amel*, whose funeral will be at St. John's on Monday. *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them!*

You'll notice new **Stations of the Cross** on the north and south walls of the church. These were hand-carved from solid white oak slabs by *Dr. Stephen Lindahl*, who lives down the street from my parents in Gladstone. He carved them last year and asked if I wanted them, so I said yes. The previous stations were put up by Fr. LaPine when the church was built. They had been repaired numerous times and were a little worn. We will bless the new stations next weekend. Also, *Andrew Pillifant* completed a **St. Joseph shrine and bench** outside the front of the church as his Eagle Scout project. We will also bless this soon ~ good job Andy!

You'll find in the bulletin a brochure describing **faith formation opportunities** this Fall. We're looking forward to offering these to help you follow our *Discipleship Pathway* through practices of *Encounter, Worship, Grow, and Serve*. Look at the brochure and pray about what you can commit to this Fall, and pass it onto others!

We'll also begin **Little Church on Sunday, September 12<sup>th</sup>** at the 11am Mass. Kids 1<sup>st</sup> grade and under who are potty-trained will go with an adult to the Fr. Ouellette Room during the liturgy of the Word for a discussion and activity about the Sunday Gospel. They'll come back for the liturgy of the Eucharist. We'll offer this each Sunday!

All middle and high school students and young adults are invited for an **outdoor adventure hike on Saturday, September 18<sup>th</sup>**. We'll meet at 10:00am in the parking lot at St. Joe's and carpool from there. We'll return between 1-1:30pm. Lunch provided during the hike. Parents are welcome, too!

Any students who have made their First Communion are invited to be **altar servers**. We will have a training for all current and new altar servers on *Saturday, September 25<sup>th</sup>* at 12:00noon-1:00pm.

**The Upper Room** is an evening of worship music, Eucharistic adoration, and prayer for more of the Holy Spirit on *Wednesday, September 8<sup>th</sup>* from 7:00-8:15pm. Mass is at 5:30pm, we'll have food from 6:00pm-7:00pm in the hall, then begin prayer at 7:00pm. Families with children are always welcome!

Our **weekly men's group** begins *Thursdays at 6:30am beginning September 9<sup>th</sup>* at St. John's parish hall. We'll begin the **Conquer Series: The Battle Plan for Purity**.
