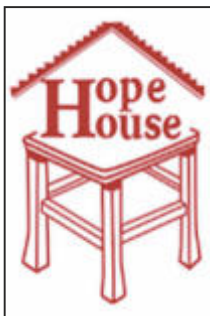

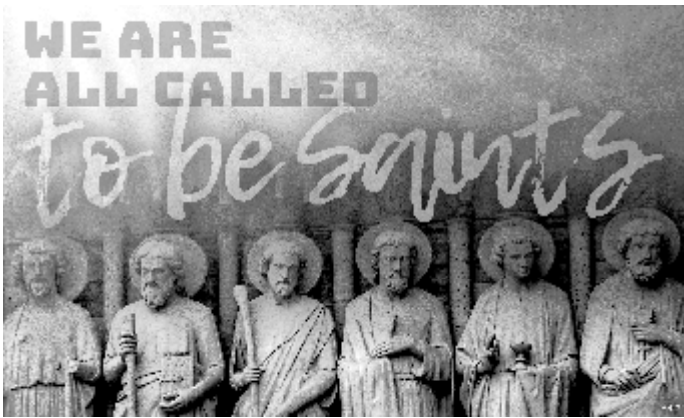

Everyday Saints

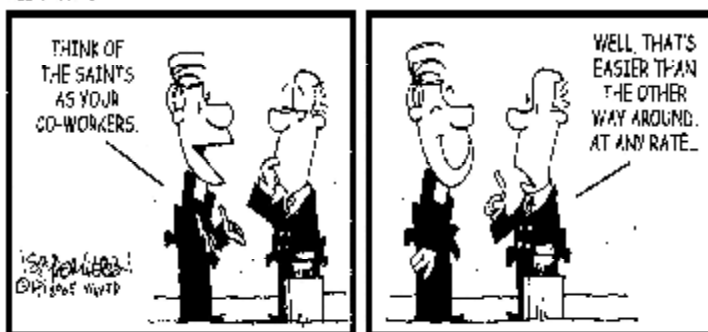
