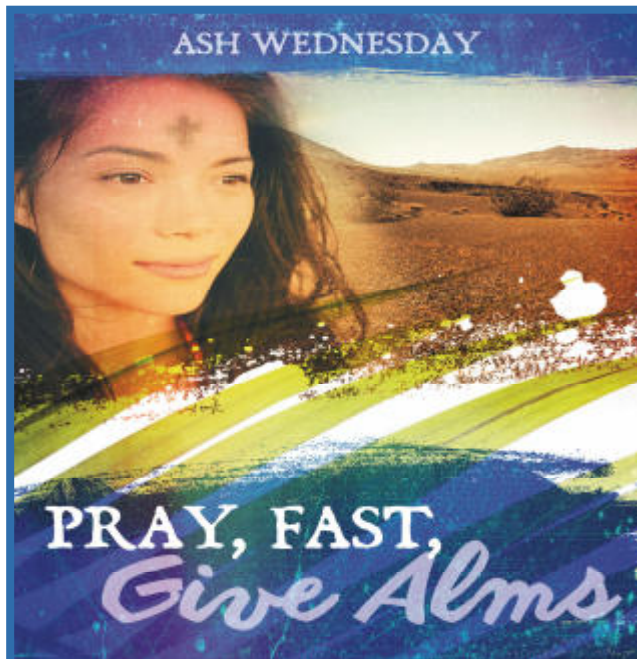

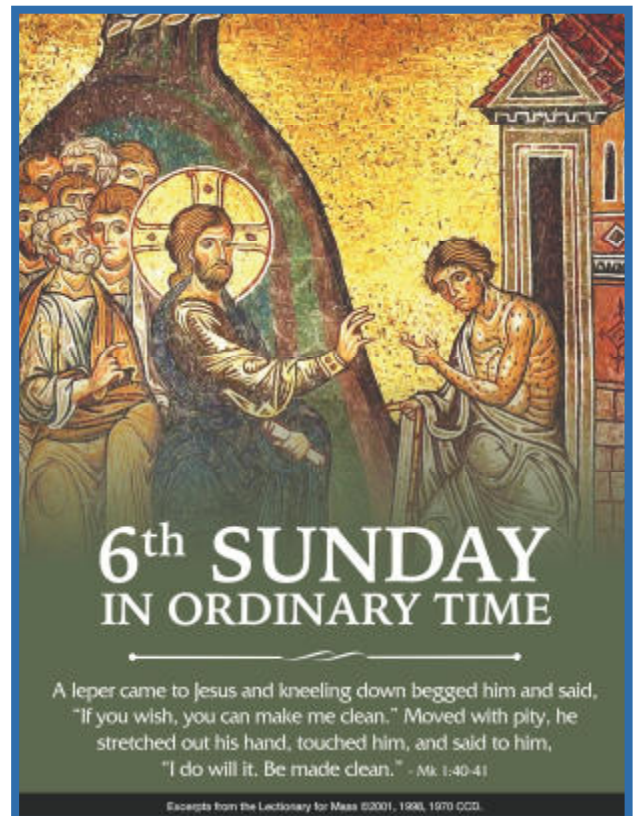

Ashes: The purpose of the “different” manner of distributing ashes this year is to ensure the health and safety of all. Blessed ashes are typically traced in the form of a cross on the foreheads. The manner in which they will be distributed this year will seem “different.” This year, Ashes will be sprinkled on the heads of those who receive them. These ashes are a sign of Lent as a season not of outward appearances, but of renewal in matters of the heart – faith, hope, and love – through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving done before the Father who sees in secret and repays (Matt 6:1--18).

Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

Take some time out, read them slowly and prayerfully, & ask yourself what God might want you to get out of them. Want to read them online? Go to: usccb.org/bible/readings

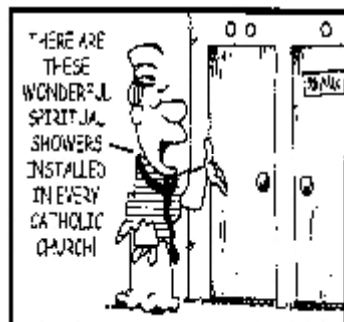
IGNITE 2021 Catholic Men's Conference Saturday, 3/20/21
