He turned to me and said, "One day, we will work together." The rest is history.

Fr. Abe had a prophetic voice. Regardless of where he was stationed, he always called forth lay people like Jim Henck and myself to take on leadership roles. He also called for congregations to become more involved in their parish as the number of priests declined. Thank God because he prepared us for the reality that we are living right now.

Fr. Abe was challenging at times, compassionate at times, and always committed to his role as Pastor and Priest, and we and many other parishes are the recipients of that grace.

It brings me great comfort that Fr. Abe is with the Lord and especially with his mother. She died when he was 16 years old, and that was a hole in his heart that never was filled. Well, it is being filled right now.

God bless you, Fr. Abe, and thank your for your constant care and concern for God's people.

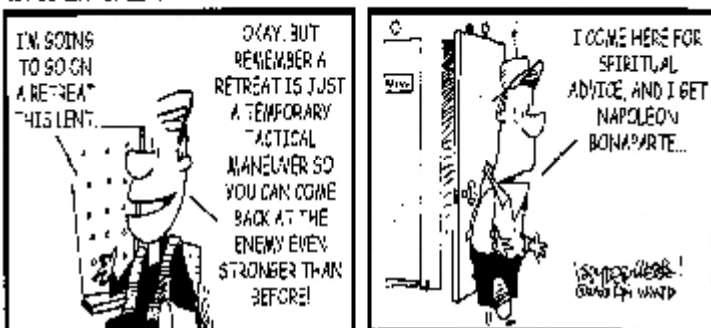
