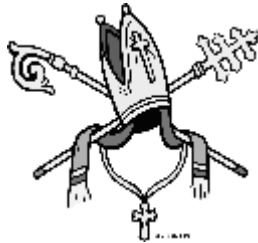

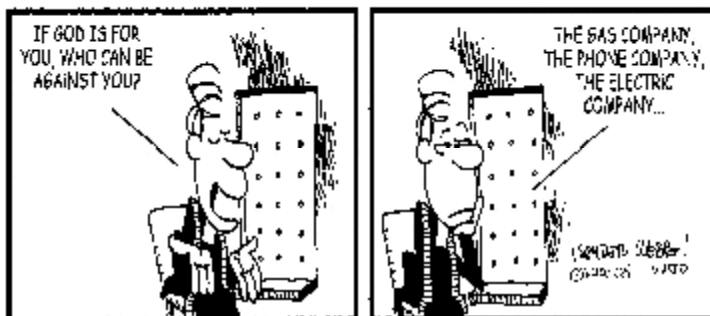
**Get Ready for Next Sunday**
