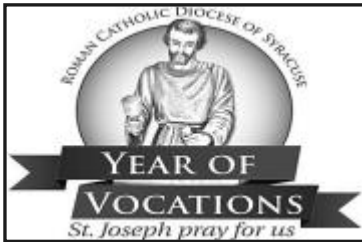

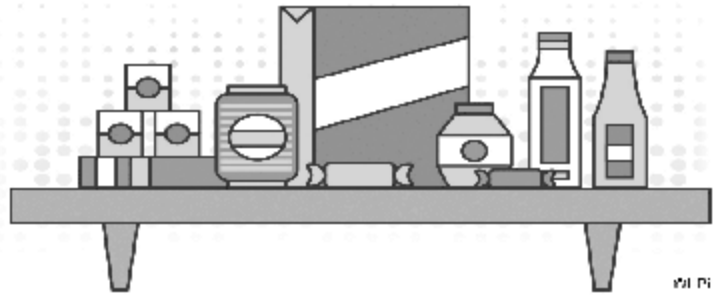
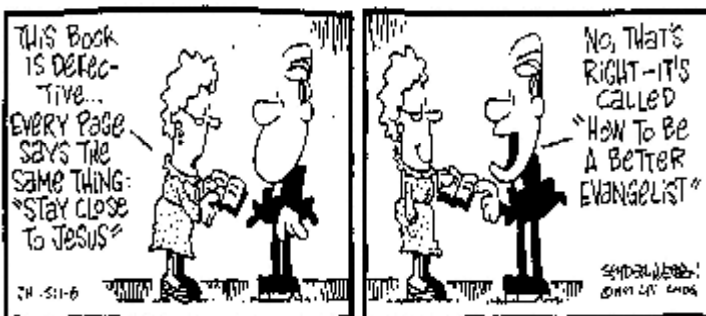
James Buttner, the Seminarian, was a resounding success in Chadwicks and Clinton last week. Not only did he speak at all of the Masses, he addressed the
