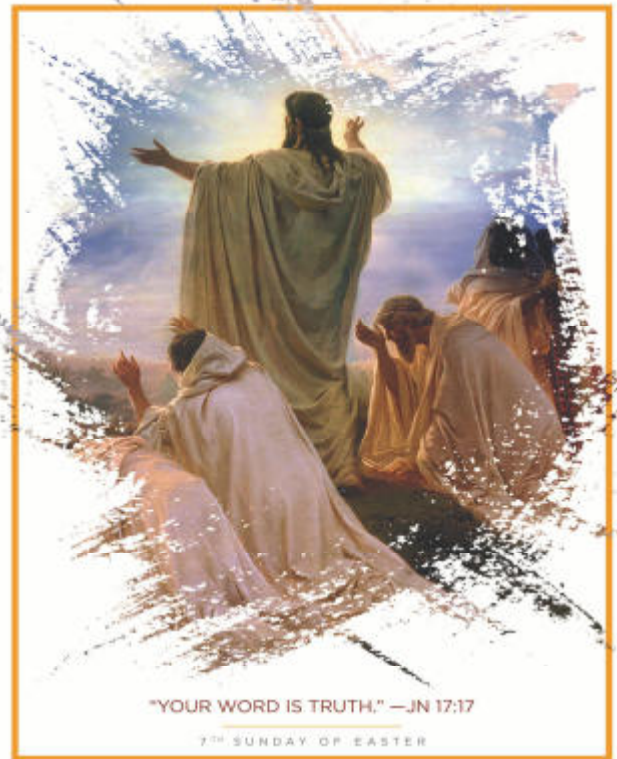

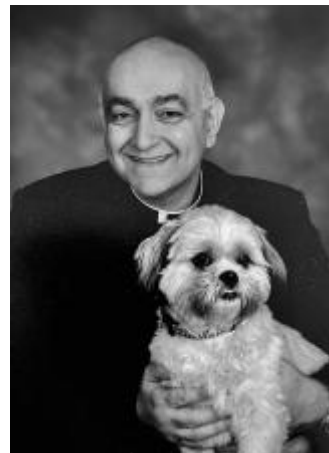
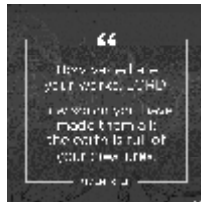
Let Us Dream...

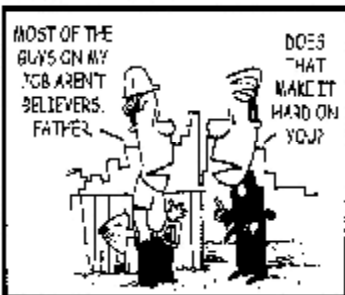
