Second Collection for the Missionary Cooperation Appeal

This weekend, **July 28 & 29** we will be hosting Fr. Edwin for our annual Visiting Missionary Appeal. Each year the Diocese of Green Bay receives over 250 applications from mission organizations to participate in this program; of these, 38 groups are invited. In our Diocese, receipts from all the parishes are pooled and then divided equally among these selected groups. The Diocese uses this fair-share system to enable our missionary speakers to go to less populated parishes in our Diocese, like St. Patrick's, without fear of receiving less income. Last year, our parish donated \$1422.00 to the Missionary Cooperation Plan.

Summer Collection Project – Shipping Container Project sponsored by the World Mission Office of the Catholic Foundation of The Diocese of Green Bay collects supplies to fill an entire shipping container to send to the Dominican Republic and Haiti. Annual Parish Picnic – Sunday, August 19, 2018

Thank you to all of the parishioners who have signed up for their picnic job. Please take a moment to sign up yourself, spouse or child/ren after Mass this weekend. Those who have not chosen their job by 7/29 will be assigned a time and job and notified by a picnic committee member by August 1st. It takes the entire parish to make this event profitable and enjoyable.

Dinner Tickets are available. For those who like to plan ahead, buy your grilled beef meal dinner tickets any weekend after Mass. ALL TICKETS bought before the day of the picnic will save \$1 off an adult meal. Meal tickets are \$12 for adults, \$11 if bought during pre-sales and \$6 for children, with no discount for pre-sales.

On the day of the picnic, one gets in line with that ticket. WE ARE NOT TRADING TICKETS FOR NUMBERS! While many of us understood the way of yesteryear, that system caused confusion to non-Parish members and new Parish members. Others complained that they had to wait because one member of their party had a later number than the rest of the group. In an effort to make everything as easy as possible, the no-number change has been made. Door ticket volunteers will only admit ticket holders when enough seats are available downstairs to accommodate the group.

If you don't like to wait, please note that the busiest times are 11:00-11:45.

Raffle Tickets: Turn in your money and ticket stubs anytime before the picnic by returning both in an envelope in the collection plate. Thank you to all that have done so & also for the gift cards that have been donated. You may turn in raffle tickets on the day of the picnic directly to the treasurers working under the camper canopy.

Donations: As in years past, parishioners are asked to donate 2 pies per family, marketplace items for sale, either for the rummage sale type area or bake sale. New this year is the request for a gift card, \$10-\$100 for the raffle.
