**Ash Wednesday – 7pm Mass – Why Ashes?** Ash Wednesday opens up this season of penitence. Ashes are a vivid reminder of our mortal nature. We are bodies fashioned from dust. Our bodies were made from nothing, and will return to nothing when we die. Ashes are a symbol of this passing world, a reminder of our death. The imposition of ashes is also a symbol of penance and sorrow for our sins.

If you can't make it to our service, Most Precious Blood Parish will have Ash Wednesday Mass-8AM and 6PM.  
MPB Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent: 2:30PM & 6:00PM .

Each Catholic is asked to preserve the penitential character of the season of Lent, which begins Ash Wednesday. Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday until they celebrate their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. These practices are designed for spiritual growth. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
